Course Details 10 Mile TT P886 ~ Rake / Petersfield / Rake B2070 (old A3)

OS Map 197 ~ Start: 827288 ~ **Finish:** 813280. To the Start turn right outside the school, take the 3rd and then the second exit at the mini roundabouts in Liphook centre onto the Portsmouth Road. Continue past the 'Links' Public House, the Golf Course to the 'Black Fox' Public House. The start area is in a layby immediately after the 'Black Fox'. Allow 10 minutes to reach the start from HQ.

Start On the Layby (25 yards before the exit) on the London Road B2070 facing towards Petersfield (South) 100 yards from the "Black Fox" public house and the turning to (North) Milland Hill. Proceed south along B2070 passing the junction opposite the "Flying Bull" PH (1.7 miles) and continue to Hill Brow (3.1 miles). Continue south on the B2070 and pass the junction (Care) with A272 (4.9 miles) until the Rams Hill roundabout at Sheet (5.17 miles).

Where turn, taking the third exit to retrace the outward route re-passing the A272 junction at 6.4 miles and Hill Brow at 8.1 miles. Continue along the B2070 passing the "Rake" sign at 9 miles to **Finish** at a point just before the turning of an unclassified road to Chapel Common opposite Coldharbour Wood approximately 100 yards from the start of the Dual Carriageway, 10 miles.

It rewards riders for taking on the more traditional and sporting courses rather than the modern drag-strips.

Please observe the CTT regulations:

Please take care when passing the slip road of the A272, as it is the fastest part of the course and you have the right of way.

Observers may be in attendance along the course. No accompanied riding (drafting), No U turns at the Start or Finish, No following cars.

Please do not warm up along the course once the event has started & please do not keep passing the Start Area, don't worry, we will not be moving it once the event has started.

Remember to grunt when passing the marshals, there is no need to wave to them or ask for time checks.

Riders should be aware of Regulation 16, which states *'the number should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in the normal riding position'*.
