Event Report



Brighton Mitre Multi 10

Monday 25 May 2009

Five events and five winners, with Tadros and Burdeau claiming the main events.

In 2008 Robin Johnson changed the format of his May Bank Holiday promotion to incorporate a variety of different events on the Steyning G10/97 course, along with the traditional Hilly on GS/995.

The flat events were a Medium Gear (72"), a Hub Gear (Tin Can), a full on Bling and an Athletes Road Bike (no tri bars). The morning finished with the Hilly event which is essentially an 8.5 mile warm up for the Steyning Bostal hill climb.

The Medium Gear only had three entrants with one DNS. Mike Marchant of Southdown Velo won with an excellent 24:56.

The Hub Gear event had a much better turn out with return visits from Dave Eccles and Minoru Mitsumoto. Dave French of Weybridge Wheelers put in an excellent 24:52 to claim top spot.

The main event was the full on Bling. It was pretty much a foregone conclusion that Pete Tadros would win, and fresh from his 17th place on the National 10 the day before, he clocked 20:56, only 9 sec off the long standing course record.

2nd, 3rd and 4th were fiercely contested with Nick Dwyer of Lewes Wanderers edging out visitor Stuart Tarry of Team Sanjan Design for 2nd. Last year's winner, Dan Paine of GS Stella had to content himself with 5th.

Next up was the Road Bike or Athletes 10. Jay Chisnell of promoting club Brighton Mitre was in a class of his own, winning in 24:45, almost 2 minutes faster than 2nd place Colin Hathaway.

The final event was the hilly which started with the arrival of the rain. The weather didn't deter Ishmael Burdeau of Agiskoviner.com from following up his 08 victory again so it was down to the minor placings. With 8 riders electing to ride two events on the morning it was a case of who was still the freshest.

In the end Mark Winton of Lewes Wanderers followed up his earlier 7th spot to claim 2nd on the hill.

The only casualty of the day was Paul Thatcher of Brighton Mitre. Having been spotted wheeling his bike towards Bramber, he missed out on the real possibility of prizes in the Bling and Hilly events. What was perhaps most bizarre was the fact that both Mark Winton and Mike Anton went back out on the course to pick him up but couldn't find him. Perhaps he decided to partake in Steyning Village fete?
