Wouter Sybrandy of Sigma Sport got his 2010 season underway with new course and events records on the GS Stella Hilly weekend.

The 2010 season opened with the 18Km and 34Km GS Stella hilly events based around Amberley / A29. The 18Km event starts in Storrington and runs through Amberley and up Houghton hill, to turn on the A29 roundabout. The longer Sunday event uses the same route but adds a further 16Km circuit taking in Slindon, the A27 and Arundel.

Cold but calm conditions met the competitors though these certainly didn't deter Sybrandy who was convincingly the man of the weekend. Runner up and the 09 winner, Pete Tadros of InGear-Quickvit was over two minutes quicker than 3rd place man Simon Ernest of AW Cycles RT but couldn't match the pace of Sybrandy.

Event sponsors Southdown Bikes, fielded a strong team to claim the overall team awards and ladies competition, which was won by Emma Craddock.

The Vets competition went to Dave Shepard who has joined GS Stella this year. Runner up was Geoff Smith of Sussex Nomads with Mel Roberton third for Worthing Excelsior.
