Will Manger & In-Gear on top. Will Manger of In-Gear Quickvit Trainsharp was in a class of his own on Saturday's 10 on the G10/87 East Hoathly course. His winning time of 20:16 was 50 seconds clear of team mate Conall Yates (21:16) who narrowly edged out Nick Dwyer of Lewes Wanderers (21:09).

Lewes Wanderers claimed both Ladies prizes with Helen Millier narrowly edging out Naomi Dandridge. Tom Baker comfortably added to the Lewes haul with fastest Junior though it was encouraging to see Dan farmer of East Grinstead out giving battle.
