# The HQ and associated rules

The HQ this year will be The Triangle Centre, located on Mill Rd, Liss, GU33 7DX. PLEASE NOTE THIS IS A CHANGE FROM PREVIOUS YEARS, It is just around the corner from the Village Hall. The HQ will be open from 3pm on Saturday and 6am on Sunday. No parking at the HQ. Car parking at the HQ is limited and is to be used by race officials only. The Liss train station car park is just around the corner from the HQ, so please use this one. Thank you all you veteran weekenderers for abiding by this request in the past, all you newbies take note! Take care when crossing the Ham Barn RAB to get to the start on Saturday.

Some rules:

- Tea, coffee and sweets are free. Donations accepted for other stuff. •
- Riders are responsible for knowing the course. Arrows and marshals are there to point the way.
- Please hang around after your event as prizes will be awarded directly afterwards. .
- Don't take pace in the event as we'll have loads of people on the course to bust your cheatin' ass. .
- Observers may be in attendance on the course. .
- No times will be given at the finish line. Results will be posted in the HQ shortly after you have • completed your ride. This will be as quick as possible to ensure that:
  - Saturday Marshals can get to the pub
  - Sunday We can vacate the hall by 12noon and go have a sleep
- Alcoholic prizes will not be posted to winners. They will instead be drunk by the organiser and his ٠ buddies. However, we may will send you the cash.
- Please use recommended safe routes to the START and for return from the FINISH to the • Headquarters.
- Do not make U turns in the vicinity of the Start or Finish •
- Do not warm up on the Course or near the Start Area •
- Keep to the side of the road waiting to start and do not obstruct the view of the Timekeeper or the . Holder-up of approaching traffic
- Exercise care when joining the A3 after the Start and the Turn ٠
- Exercise care when passing exit and entry slip roads at all interchanges on the A3 •
- Do not stop at the Finish but continue to the Event Headquarters .
- REAR LIGHTS. It is a Course requirement that all competitors' machines be fitted with a working . rear light, either flashing or constant.

### IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY,

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15, ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear protective Hard Shell Helmets.



# Course details

### Official Course description: P881/10 (https://www.strava.com/segments/1112938)

**START** on B3006 Selbourne Road, at a point 17 yards north of the centre of three concrete manhole covers in the tarmac path and 190 yards north of Ham Barn RAB at junction with A3 (SU 772297) PROCEED to Ham Barn RAB and take 1<sup>st</sup> Exit on to A3 (signposted Guildford and London). Proceed north east on A3 passing two exit slip roads (1) the A325 to Farnham and (2) an unclassified road to Griggs Green. Take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit slip road on to B2171 (signposted Haslemere and Liphook) to cross the Bramshott Flyover where **TURN** (SU 843324) (5.4 Miles). Take 1<sup>st</sup> exit to turn LEFT on to slip road to re-join the A3 and proceed south west, (signposted Petersfield and Portsmouth). Retrace on A3 to **FINISH** at a point 10 yards south west of entry to lay-by, after passing under bridge and 0.554 miles north east of Ham Barn RAB. (SU 775297) (10 Miles).



#### Some Notes:

1. It's a simple out and back people. If you stuff this one up there is truly no hope for you and you'll have to revert to closed circuit racing....

2. You'll have to cross the train line to get to the start so bear in mind the barriers might come down for a few minutes!! Best to leave in plenty of time for the start and warm up on the other side of Ham Barn RAB.

3. Course record is a 19:01.

### Official Course description: P885 (https://www.strava.com/segments/664286)

**START** at Hill Brow on B2070 London Road facing towards Petersfield in a small lay-by approximately 500 yards south west of crossroads with B3006 from Liss and at the start of a dual carriageway. (SU 783258). PROCEED south west along B2070 to join A272 (Care) where straight on to Ramshill RAB at Sheet. (SU 756271) (2.1 miles). Take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to stay on A272 to Sheet Interchange. (2.8 miles). Take 1<sup>st</sup> exit slip road before crossing flyover (signposted Portsmouth) to join A3. PROCEED south west on A3 passing the1st exit road at the Petersfield Interchange (signposted Winchester and Petersfield) to take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit slip road signposted Buriton where **TURN** (SU 728209) (6.0 miles). Follow slip road to Buriton RAB where take 1<sup>st</sup> exit under A3 to re-join A3(signposted Guildford and London). PROCEED north on A3 passing three exit slip roads: (1) Petersfield Interchange; (2) Sheet Interchange and (3) Princes Bridge Interchange to Ham Barn RAB (SU 772295) (13.0 miles). Take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to stay on A3 and continue north passing two exit slip roads: (1) the A325 to Farnham and (2) an unclassified road to Griggs Green. Take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit slip road on to B2171 (signposted Haslemere and Liphook) to cross the Bramshott Flyover where **TURN** (SU 843324) (18.2 miles). Take 1<sup>st</sup> exit to turn LEFT on to slip road to re-join the A3 and proceed south west, (signposted Petersfield and Portsmouth). Retrace to Ham Barn RAB (SU 772295) Take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to continue on the A3 towards Petersfield, past the lay-by to the Princes Bridge Interchange where take the exit slip road signposted Liss B3006 to: **FINISH** on the slip road 25 yards before lamppost 513/002 alongside a storm drain cover. (SU 769270) (25 miles).

#### Some notes:


1. Left out of the HQ and up a ruddy gert hill and turn left to the start (approx. 2 miles). Please allow at least 10 mins from HQ. 2. South turn at Buriton is pictured below.

3. At finish you can ride back to the HQ easily. 50 yds. after finish take 2nd exit at RAB and 1st left (Andlers Ash Rd).

4. For all you A3 veterans this is the new faster finish where you go straight over Ham Barn to finish on the Princes Bridge Interchange. Don't stuff it up!!!!

5. Course record is 49:33 so it's reasonably rapid.
