Thank you in advance for not wearing cycling shoes or CLEATS in the Village hall.

Numbers at HQ ONLY.

After the event, please remember to return to the HQ with your number to sign out after your ride.
You can exchange your number for a FREE drink.

10 Mile Event – HQ to start 0.04 miles, and 0.46miles from the finish

25 Mile Event – HQ to start 0.04 miles, and 0.38 miles from the finish.

Please note the following CTT regulations and recommendations

Helmets: CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

Competitors' Machines: It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

Competitors' Vehicles: No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish (District regulation).

Safety Instructions: Details of any additional hazards not listed on the start sheet will be displayed at the signing on point.

Warming Up: Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the event has started.

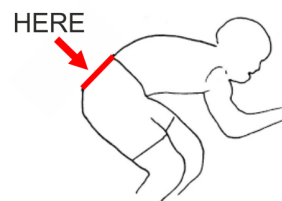
Observers: Official observers will be stationed around the course to ensure correct procedure (e.g. drafting and safety at roundabouts).

Results: No times will be given out at the finish line.

Race Numbers: The race number is made of fluorescent material which is an important safety feature. It is essential that it is placed correctly for maximum visibility to other road users and of course the timekeepers.

Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and Arm Numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forwards (not inwards).

Be aware that "No time may be recorded if the number is incorrectly positioned".



Additional Safety Instructions

The location of Oakwood Hill Village Hall relative to the course means that there is nowhere off the course for warming up. Competitors are therefore requested to use one of the following options:-

- Turn LEFT out of the hall and ride down Honeywood Lane to the junction with Horsham Road. LEFT into Horsham Road down to Rowhook. Return to the hall by the same route, taking care not to obstruct Competitors already racing.
- Follow route as above but continue through Rowhook to A29; LEFT on A29 to Ruckmans Lane; LEFT up Ruckmans Lane to junction with Honeywood Lane; LEFT to return to hall (this circuit is approximately 6.5 miles).

Competitors must exercise extra care when passing the start area and when joining the A29.

When crossing Honeywood Lane to reach the start Competitors MUST take care not to impede earlier Competitors racing up Honeywood Lane.

After finishing Competitors should go straight on past the Start to Oakwood Hill Village Hall, taking care not to obstruct any Competitors still racing in Honeywood Lane.

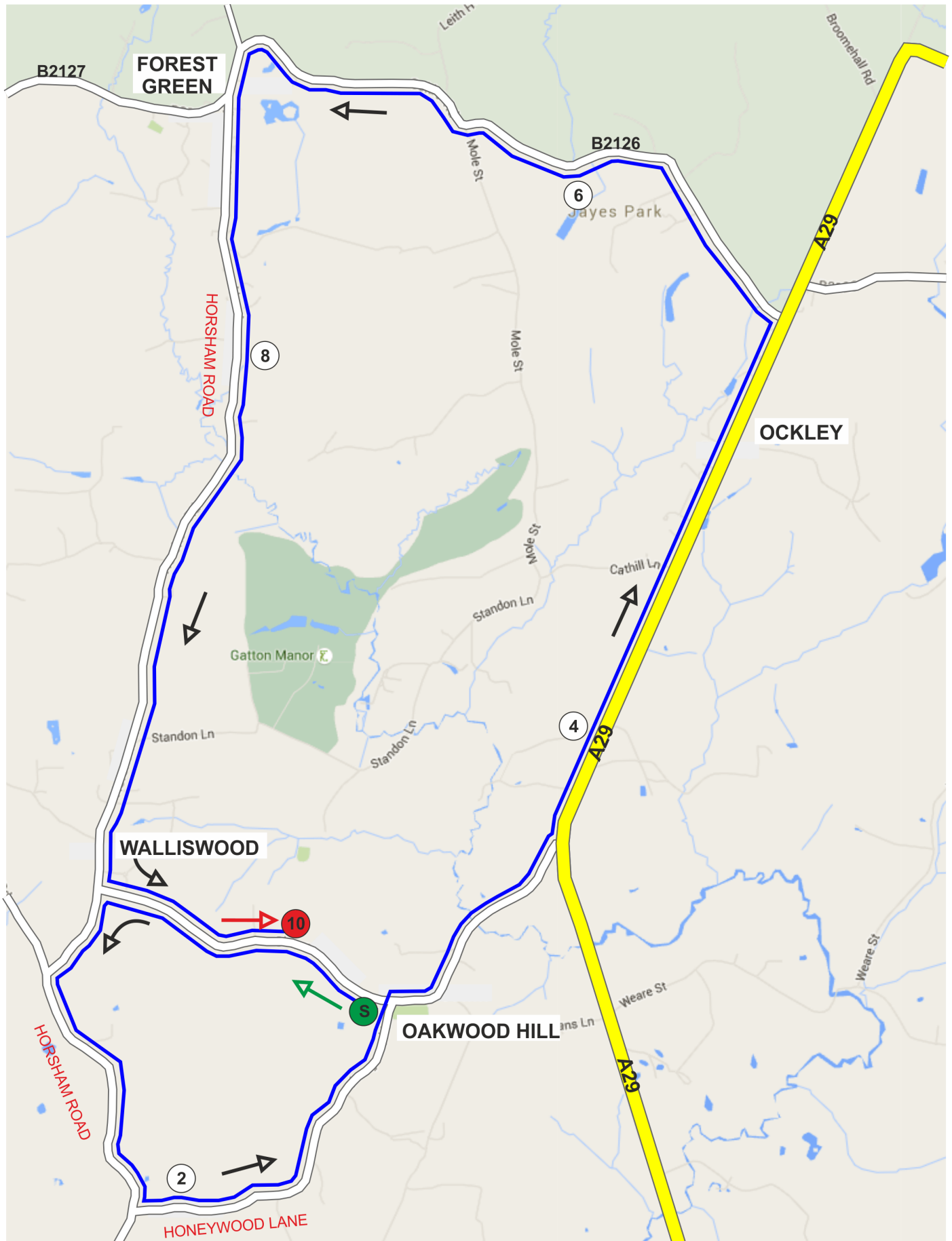

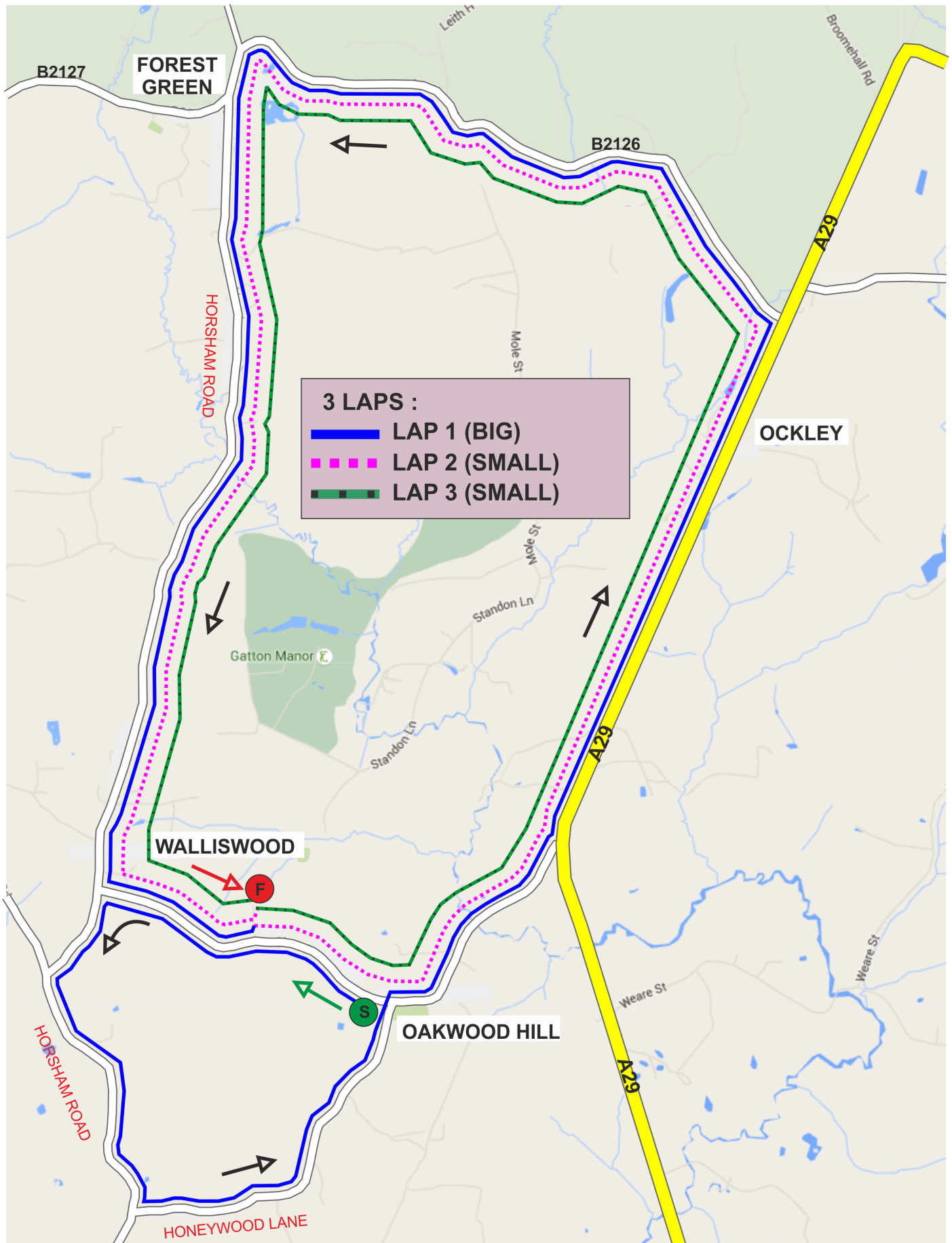

Thank you for entering this Southern Counties Cycling promotion. If you are a member of an affiliated club we would like to draw your attention to the trophies that the SCCU owns and annually awards. You and your club mates can compete for these in events that are held throughout the racing season.

All SCCU events count for trophies, and where applicable the South Eastern RC Open 10.

Season long awards:

Mens' individual BAR (Claud Butler Trophy) based on the best average speed at 25, 50 and 100 miles.

Team BAR (Amateur Cup) best of three (men or women) from any one club.

Veterans' BAR (John Smith Cup) (men and women) based on VTTA standards.

Womens' BAR (Fleming Cup) based on the best average speed at 10, 25 and 50 miles.

Junior BAR Coronation Cup) based on the best average speed at 10 and 25 miles.

Rawson Shield awarded annually to club with the highest number of entrants in SCCU road promotions.

Specific awards:

Fountain Cup - fastest SCCU member in a Union promoted 25 miles TT.

Robin Marsh Trophy - fastest SCCU junior in a SCCU 25.

Vice-Presidents' Tankard - fastest SCCU member in the Union's Open 50 miles TT.

Roberts Shield - best team of three SCCU members in the Union's Open 50 miles TT.

Tacagni Cup - fastest SCCU member in Open 50 not previously having beaten 1:03:00, 2:10:00, 4:30:00

Syd Gray Shield - best team of three SCCU members in the Union's Open 100 miles TT.
