RESULT IN TIME ORDER

Riders without a handicap (N/A) did not have any previous times on their entry forms, or are ineligible (blank) because their club is not affiliated to the SCCU.

The new CTT system of having to enter a previous time played havoc with the Tacagni Cup and the handicap. Matt Peel confirmed he had not ridden a 50 before, and coming 2nd to Mark Smith (who has definitely ridden before), makes him a worthy candidate and winner.

The # in the 3rd column together with grey shading represents riders whose clubs are NOT affiliated to the SCCU, and therefore not eligible for the Association awards.

Mark Smith once again proved to be the fastest, who not only improved on last years time by 4 minutes, but also **broke the Course Record** of 1:49:31 held by Steve Dennis, East Grinstead CC, since 2009 on a day when despite the outwardly look of a good day, proved to be slower for many than last year!!

Mark went on to be the fastest veteran on time, but could not match David Shepherd GS Stella on age standard with a healthy plus of 22 minutes. 2nd on age standard, missing out by a mere 10 seconds was Mike O’Gorman, Worthing Excelsior who had slipped back a little from his plus last year of 23:53.

Mark also led Crawley Wheelers to Team victory, backed up by Paul batten and Alan Yule, whose combined time of 6:01:52 was some 13 minutes adrift of their winning time last year

Laura Bartlett was the fastest lady, although with A3crg not being a SCCU member, those honours went to Madelaine Lee-Smith of Oxted Cycle Club.

Congratulations not just to all the prize-winners, but to everyone who rode on this course, which we know is much harder than the old G50/53, but we have little choice given the wholesale development of the road system in this crowded part of the South East.

I’m pleased to note that everyone complied with the new CTT rule and signed back in at the end of their ride, even though some took longer than others!!!!

Many thanks to everyone who helped make the event a success – much work goes on unnoticed behind the scenes, mainly by Tony Alston arranging the marshals, who all did a great job, and his fantastic rock cakes. Also many thanks to Bryn Tully for putting out all the direction signs, making the route really clear.
