WEBMASTER'S REPORT

As reported at the November AGM for 2019 the SCA website is now restricted to details for SCA events, SCA competitions, courses (including club courses) and minutes. This is because due to the much improved CTT site there is now no need to include start sheets and results sheets for other events.

In support of the improved CTT site I have submitted details for all Sussex Open courses into the CTT site where they can now be found.

Course GS/195 has been added (to both the SCA site and to the CTT site). Courses G10/59 and G10/69 have been added to the SCA site. There is possibly a G10/95 course but I have been unable to receive any confirmation from Paul Tunnell.

When 2019 Competition details are available (including list of SPOCO events) then they will be added into the site. The Honours Board is up to date with all 2018 results included.

As discussed at the AGM I ran the re-affiliation process for all clubs using the facility of [semi-online affiliation](#) process which I set up in 2016. David Shepherd and Paul Thatcher were kept in the loop. The number of clubs has dropped from 26 to 24. In-Gear changed themselves into trainSharp. Velopace (now Beachy Head CC) and Hunt Bike Wheels - both inactive anyway - chose not to renew.
