RESULT IN TIME ORDER

Riders without a handicap (N/A) did not have any previous times on their entry forms, or are ineligible (blank) because their club is not affiliated to the SCCU.

Riders 23, 28, 31, 32, 33, 34, 42, 43, 47, 48, 51, 52, 53, 57, 63, 71, 72, 77, 78, 84, 85 and 87 were eligible for the Tacagni Cup, not having previously ridden a 50.

The Tacagni Cup which is awarded to the fastest rider who has not ridden a 50 before is shown by N in the 3rd Column indicating “novice”

With no entry from Steve Kane this year, we have a new winner from the Crawley Wheelers and hearty congratulations must go to Mark Smith to produce a 1:52:41 around this course is an awesome ride, although run close by Pete Morris, 1:53:01, who actually equaled his time recorded last year!!! (Pete doesn't feature as his club, Team ASL 360 are not affiliated to the SCCU)

Mark went on to be the fastest veteran on time, 2nd on age standard, missing out by a mere 23 seconds to Mike O'Gorman, Worthing Excelsior who had a plus of 23:53. Mark was also the fastest SCCU rider, and took the handicap prize by virtue of a 6 minute improvement on his PB!!!!

Mark also led Crawley Wheelers to Team victory, backed up by Brindley Taylor – 1:53:57 in his FIRST EVER 50.....and Stu Nesbitt, just a shade over the 2 hour mark, followed by Epsom CC and third Worthing Excelsior CC.

Mel Waseley was the fastest lady having beaten a previous winner, Helen Bullimore by some 10 minutes.....

Congratulations not just to all the prize-winners, but to everyone who rode on this course, which we know is much harder than the old G50/53, but we have little choice given the wholesale development of the road system in this crowded part of the South East.

Many thanks to everyone who helped make the event a success – much work goes on unnoticed behind the scenes, mainly by Tony Alston arranging the marshals, who all did a great job. Also many thanks to Bryn Tully for putting out all the direction signs, making the route really clear, and most definitely to Rod Starmer for his great baking abilities!!
