An Ambulance was called, the Paramedic suspected a broken Collar bone and took her off to hospital. The broken bone was mended and she is home now safe and sound.

When I spoke to her a few days ago, she stated "I am fine now" and sent her thanks to the helpers on the island.

This event was the first time trial that Fiona had ever ridden and her second time round the Circuit.
